



2021-22 SCHOLARSHIP AUDITION REQUIREMENTS FOR NEW STUDENTS

Deadline to Submit: April 18, 2021

Entry Level – New student applicants can participate in the audition process on any instrument or voice offered at the Wisconsin Conservatory of Music. We encourage highly motivated students at any level of accomplishment to apply, including those at the early stages of their musical study.

New students currently in grades 8-11 may also choose to audition for our Honors Jazz Program and/or our Advanced Chamber Music Institute. Visit www.wcmusic.org for more details and audition requirements for these programs.

Audition Material – Each participant must perform two contrasting pieces by different composers which demonstrate current technical proficiency and lyrical style. Memorization is optional. Additionally, new student applicants must include a brief letter of recommendation from a past or present music teacher.

Evaluation – Students are evaluated based on their musicality, potential, and motivation. All judges' decisions are final.
